IELTS at EXCEL – Excel at IELTS

Recently we had a close look at our IELTS course and have decided to make some changes in the material and way the course is taught. The course will now be run in three 6-week cycles giving it a total length of 18 weeks. Students can still join it at any time. The new structure of the course means that it involves more intensive study

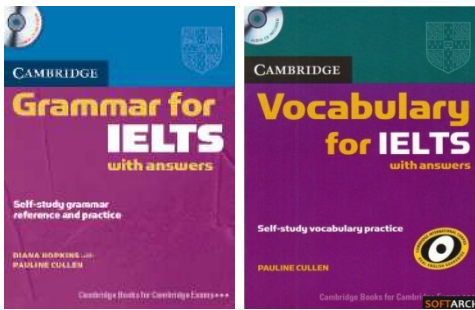


than before and will ultimately assist students in reaching their IELTS goals faster. Each 6-week cycle consists of

- 4 weeks of **language building and IELTS exam skills** and
- 2 weeks of **intensive IELTS exam preparation.**

Each student will also be provided with supplementary material for each of the 24 units covered over the 18-week, full course period. This includes hints on passing the exam, a grammar & vocabulary list and internet resources for further study.

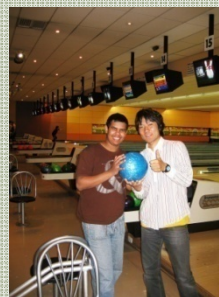
Building on the past success of Excel's IELTS course, these changes will make it even better!
